#### Gear up for the new school year

We curated resources from across the Regional Educational Laboratory (REL) Program to help districts and schools support new teachers and leaders, ensure smooth transitions for young learners, and create welcoming school environments as a new academic year begins.

#### **REL resource roundup: Back to school**



#### Supporting new teachers and leaders

A 30-minute REL Midwest documentary on best practices for supporting new educators features three novice teachers in Metro Detroit whose experiences highlight the importance of quality preparation, clinical experience, and ongoing mentorship. A REL Northeast and Islands video describes how Boston Public Schools is mentoring beginning teachers through data coaching, and a REL Mid-Atlantic fact sheet provides information on teacher residency programs in the United States, including features of high-performing programs.



### **Ensuring smooth transitions for young learners**

A REL Midwest video, Kindergarten Entry Assessments: What You Need to Know, describes the benefits of identifying students' strengths and needs at the start of kindergarten, and a webinar, Equipping Parents to Support Kindergarten Readiness, explores how child care providers can help parents prepare children for the nonacademic components of kindergarten. In addition, a new What Works Clearinghouse practice guide provides evidence-based recommendations to help prepare young children for school, and a REL Mid-Atlantic fact sheet highlights promising practices for supporting school transitions.



### Creating a welcoming school environment

A REL Midwest infographic highlights resources for creating a supportive learning environment that values equity and two videos describe evidence-based practices for creating culturally affirming classrooms and positive high school climates. In addition, two REL Northwest blog posts feature ways to create welcoming, bully-free online learning environments and six strategies for effective school-based family engagement events.
